MAIN INFORMATION FOR BEGINNER STUDENTS

During the academic year, CIS (Italian courses for foreigners) section will organize the following courses:

Semester Courses

- Generic (60 hours)

5 levels (Beginner to Advanced A1-C1), in both academic semesters (September to January, February to May)

- Special (30 hours)

Writing (from level B2 upwards; I and II semester), Italian culture (from level B1 upwards; I semester), Italian Culture 2 (from level B2 upwards, II semester), Oral Comprehension and Production (from level A2 to level B1, I and II semester), Expressive pronunciation and reading (from level A2; I and II semester).

Courses include an entry test and a final verification test, the results of which can be certified by students' request. The courses of Italian language are free of charge, but it's compulsory to buy the textbook.

CFU (Course Credit) benefit:

- Erasmus/exchange students: 6 credits for generic courses and 3 credits for specials. To take the final test and acquire credits, Erasmus students must attend at least 50% of lessons.
- Student of the master degree course "Philosophical knowledge: Foundation, Methods, Applications": 3 credits for the generic course of level A2-Pignolo. The final test is compulsory to acquire credits.



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- Students of the master degree courses “Accounting, Governance and Sustainability” and “International Management and Marketing”: 6 credits for the generic course of level A2 Caniana (it is also possible to split the course in two years: 3 credits in the first year for the generic course of level A1 Caniana and 3 credits in the second year for the generic course of level A2-Caniana).

Livello B2: lingua generale (sede: Pignolo), corso speciale Cultura, corso speciale di Scrittura;

Livello C1: lingua generale (sede: Pignolo), corso speciale Cultura, corso speciale Scrittura.
